- FESA 331 - Structure Influence on Tactics and Strategy, 3 cr.** Instructor: Larry Grosse  
How construction type, alterations, design and materials influence a building's reaction to fire.  
Fireground influence on tactics and strategy.
- FESA 333 - Proposals/Reports in Fire Service Mgmt., 3 cr.** Instructor: Mary Sovick  
Process of preparing reports and developing a proposal supported by research. Introduction to research  
techniques, Internet and library use; conventions of documentation.
- FESA 334 - Orientation to Experiential Learning, 1 cr.** Instructor: Mary Sovick  
Demonstration of knowledge, skill, and professional experience for the purpose of enhancing  
documentation and career development skills.  
**Restriction:** Students admitted to FESA Bachelor of Science program only; course not open to  
Certificate of Completion students
- FESA 336 - Fire and Emergency Services Management, 3 cr.** Instructor: Warren Jones  
Fire and emergency service administrative structures and processes. Examination of management and  
leadership models and applications.
- FESA 338 - Essentials of Emergency Management, 3 cr.** Instructor: Lonnie Inzer  
Emergency management theory; mitigation, planning, response and recovery in large-scale incidents.  
Development/operation of emergency operation centers.
- FESA 432 - Fire and Emergency Services Budgeting, 3 cr.** Instructor: Warren Jones  
Application of emergency service budgeting systems with emphasis on revenues, public financial  
controls, capital funding and performance measures.
- FESA 434 - Training Programs Management, 3 cr.** Instructor: Kevin Milan  
Development of agency training and education programs. Utilization of training and education  
practices, resources, facilities and technologies.
- FESA 437 - Fire and Emergency: Legal Considerations, 3 cr.** Instructor: D.J. Himstedt  
Examination of the fire service in relation to the complex legal system of the United States, individual  
states, and local jurisdictions.  
**NOTE:** This is a brand new course, separate from FESA 337-Policy and Legal Foundations. The course title to  
FESA 337 has been changed to reflect the addition of this new course. FESA 437 is NOT a substitute for FESA 337.
- FESA 492 - Seminar, 3 cr.** Instructor: Larry Grosse  
Development, organization, analysis, and presentation of a practical project outside the student's party/  
department/agency (ex: City Manager's office, local schools, or building official).  
**Restriction:** Students admitted to FESA Bachelor of Science program only; course not open to  
Certificate of Completion students
- FESA 495 - Independent Study, 1-6 cr. (consult instructor for credit recommendation)**  
Independent study project to be determined by student and supervising instructor. **Additional paper-  
work must be filed prior to registration.** Contact Kelli Heenan for more information and instructions.
