Summer 2009 Course Offerings*

FESA 331 - Structure Influence on Tactics and Strategy, 3 cr.

How construction type, alterations, design and materials influence a building's reaction to fire. Fireground influence on tactics and strategy. Course introduces how buildings stay up, so students can better understand how they can fail and fall down.

FESA 335 - Trends in Fire Science Technologies, 3 cr.

Analytical tools designed to evaluate, align, select and implement emerging fire science technologies.

FESA 337 - Policy and Legal Foundations, 3 cr.

Political and legal foundations of fire and emergency services. Public administration concepts, decision making and policy development. Course covers political foundations of American government and public administration.

FESA 438 - Prevention Program Management, 3 cr.

Design, implementation and evaluation of fire and risk prevention programs using education, engineering and enforcement approaches. Course covers needs assessment, staffing, budgeting and program management evaluation for programs including code enforcement, inspection, fire and life safety education and other community risk reduction programs.

FESA 492 - Seminar, 1-3 cr. (student should register for 3 credits)

Development, organization, analysis, and presentation of a practical project outside the student's party/department/agency (ex: City Manager's office, local schools, or building official).

RESTRICTION: Students admitted to FESA Bachelor of Science program only; course not open to Certificate of Completion students.

FESA 495 - Independent Study, 1-6 cr.

Independent study project to be determined by student and supervising instructor.
