**FESA 334 – Orientation to Experiential Learning**, 1 cr. Instructor: Mary Sovick  
Demonstration of knowledge, skill and professional experience for the purpose of enhancing documentation and career development skills.

**RESTRICTION:** Students admitted to the FESA Bachelor of Science program ONLY.

**COURSE DATES:** January 19 – March 12 (for this course only)

**FESA 336 – Fire and Emergency Services Management**, 3 cr. Instructor: Warren Jones  
Fire and emergency service administrative structures and processes. Examination of management and leadership models and applications.

**FESA 337 – Policy and Public Administration**, 3 cr. Instructor: Paul Grant  
Political and legal foundations of fire and emergency services. Public administration concepts, decision making and policy development.

**FESA 338 – Essentials of Emergency Management**, 3 cr. Instructor: Lonnie Inzer  
Emergency management theory; mitigation, planning, response and recovery in large-scale incidents. Development/operation of emergency operation centers.

**FESA 339 – Incident Command Systems**, 3 cr. Instructor: Eric Morgenthaler  
Theory and application of incident command systems (ICS) to the command and coordination of major emergency operations.

**FESA 431 – Emergency Medical Services Management**, 3 cr. Instructor: David Becker  
Emergency medical service models, design implementation evaluation. Interactions with health care systems, public policy and public health systems.

**FESA 433 – Fire and Emergency: Human Resources**, 3 cr. Instructor: Shawn Bayouth  
Theory, practice and models of human resources applied to emergency organizations; workforce development, HR functions and labor relations.

**FESA 436 – Fire Protection Through Model Building Codes**, 3 cr. Instructor: James Reid  
Overview of the most current fire codes that are used across the United States. Discussion of fire inspection methodology and enforcement practices.

**FESA 467 – Integrated Management Simulation**, 3 cr. Instructor: Warren Jones  
Integration management and administrative knowledge and skills in the development of a fire and emergency service management simulation. Taught during spring semester only; take course during graduation year.

**RESTRICTION:** Students admitted to the FESA Bachelor of Science program ONLY.

**FESA 492 – Seminar**, 3 cr. Instructor: Larry Grosse  
Development, organization, analysis and presentation of a practical project outside the student's party/department/agency (ex: city manager's office, local school, or building official).

**RESTRICTION:** Students admitted to the FESA Bachelor of Science program ONLY.

**FESA 495 – Independent Study**, 1-6 cr. (consult instructor for credit recommendation)  
Individualized independent study project to be determined by instructor and student. **Additional paperwork must be filed prior to registration.** Contact Kelli Heenan for more info and instructions.
